RULES:

- All rabbits and guinea pigs shown must be owned by the exhibitor, not less than 30 days prior to show.
- All Rabbit and Guinea pigs must be inspected prior to penning. All animals must be in good health, clean and free of ear mites..

- Rabbit feed donated by **Smithers Feed Store** (guinea pig exhibitors must provide their own feed). Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own exhibits by 9:00 am. (Failure to do so will result in disqualification)
- An exhibitor can enter up to a maximum of two rabbits or guinea pigs in a class.
- Exhibitors can provide their own containers.
- Exhibitors must specify** breed and variety in all classes on entry form. (Failure to do so will result in disqualification)
- All animals **MUST** remain in their cages during the Fair.
- Drop off between 9 am and 10:30 am Thursday. All stock must be caged by 11 am.
- Judging starts 1 pm Thursday. Exhibitors must attend and are responsible for bringing their animals to the judging table. Rabbits or guinea pigs left in their cages will not be judged. Judges will have two 15 min. breaks at approximately 2:30 pm and 4:00 pm.
- Trophies/ribbons will be presented after judging.
- No rabbits or guinea pigs to leave show area until after 5 pm Sunday. All animals must be removed by 6 pm Sunday.
- Rabbits' and guinea pigs' toenails must be clipped.
- All rabbit and guinea pig cages must be cleaned before exhibitor leaves. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of Prize Money.
