#### **RULES:**

- Goat show is open to Nigerian Dwarf or pygmy Goats; Classes for Registered and Grades
- If only one entry in class, 1<sup>st</sup> place ribbon may be awarded but only 2<sup>nd</sup> place money.
- All Goats must be free from communicable diseases and have no horns
- Goats MUST be checked before unloading
- Goats MUST be on the Fairgrounds between 1-6 pm Thursday. When arriving, check with the director/assistant before unloading.

**Show:** Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> – 1:00 pm (after 4-H Show, approximately 12:30-1:00 pm.)

**Prize Money (unless otherwise stated):**

1<sup>st</sup> \$50, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$30, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$20, Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place. If only one entry in class, 1<sup>st</sup> place ribbon may be awarded but only 2<sup>nd</sup> place money.

#### **RULES:**

- All sheep must have CSIP/EID/RFID tags and the # must be listed on entry form.
- All sheep must be free from Keds and communicable diseases
- Sheep MUST be checked before unloading
- Sheep must be on the Fairgrounds between 1-3 pm Thursday. When arriving, check with the director/assistant before unloading.
- Class 403-425 MUST fill out an entry form and submit by deadline due to limited stalling.

**Pigeons:** \$1 per entry

**Entry Deadline:** August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024

#### **RULES:**

- All birds must be owned, not less than 30 days prior to show, by the exhibitor.
- All Birds must be inspected prior to cooping. All birds must be in good health, clean and free of leg mites.
- Poultry feed donated by **Smithers Feed Store**. All exhibitors will be responsible for feeding, watering and cleanup of their own exhibits by 9:00 am. (Failure to do so will result in disqualification)
- An Exhibitor can enter a maximum of 2 birds per class.
- Exhibitors can provide containers.
- Pigeon exhibitors must provide their own feed.
- Exhibitors must specify breed** and variety in all classes on entry form (failure to do so will result in disqualification). For a list of Light and and Heavy Breeds go to: [www.bvfair.ca/exhibition/prizebook](http://www.bvfair.ca/exhibition/prizebook)
- All poultry **MUST** remain in their cages during the fair.
- Drop off and inspections between 9 am and 10:30 am Thursday. All poultry must be caged by 11 am.
- Judging time: 1/2 hour after the end of the Rabbit Show. Trophies and Ribbons placed at end of day.
- No poultry to leave show area until 5 pm Sunday. All animals must be removed by 6 pm Sunday.
- All pens must be cleaned before exhibitor leaves. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of any prize money.
