EXHIBITOR'S GUIDELINES: Baking Powder Biscuits: should have fairly smooth surface, delicately browned, tender-crisp crust with a slightly moist interior, flaky and tender, pleasant flavor. / Cakes: should have a flat or slightly rounded top, moist, fine grain, slightly glossy surface, fine velvety texture. Does not crumble significantly when cut. Has a characteristic, pleasant flavor. / Muffins: should be lightly browned, symmetrical, bumpy rough surface. Tiny holes, not tunnels. / Yeast Breads: should have smooth rounded top, evenly browned, thin crusts, moist interior, fine, even interior texture, light pleasant taste and pleasant aroma. Decorate or ice only if stated.

#### **Judging Standards:**

- General appearance: 30%
- Internal appearance or texture: 30%
- · Flavor/Aroma: 40%
