T4: Quilting

Entry Fee: \$2

Prize Money: 1st \$15; 2nd \$10; 3rd \$5

Note: all quilts to be dropped off August 15th from 5-9 pm OR August 16th from 10-2 pm. All other textiles to be dropped off August 20th between 10 and 4pm.

Prize Money Pick-up: Aug. 25th 12–4pm BVX office.

- Item must not have been exhibited at the fair previously
- Quilts must have three (3) layers
- Quilters with any level of experience may enter in T4 classes
- Exhibits must be clean and free from pet hair.
- Piecing is accurately stitched, free from errors, free from puckering.
- Quilting is evenly stitched with uniform stitches, whether by hand or machine.
- Piecing and quilting must be the work of the exhibitor unless stated differently in an individual class.
- Long arm quilting may be done by a professional
- Knots should be hidden in the batting.
- Pattern marks should not be obvious.
- Binding should be even, filled and with secure neat corners or turns
- Any style of quilt can be entered in the appropriate technique class.
- Cover your name if it is visible on your quilt.
- NOTE: Bed/lap quilt size must be greater than perimeter of 200". Crib quilt size must have perimeter of 200" or less.
