- 4) Sheep must be on the Fairgrounds between 1-3 pm Thursday. When arriving, check with the director/assistant before unloading.
- 5) Class 401-444 MUST fill out an entry form and submit by deadline due to limited stalling.

- 4) An Exhibitor can enter a maximum of 2 birds per class.
- 5) Exhibitors can provide containers.
