### Camping Reservations Strongly recommended for 2022

CAMPING ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY! If you are not an exhibitor, the gate staff will allocate you a camping spot. If you are an exhibitor, you must stay within your divisions camping area. 18 & under campers must be accompanied by a parent or a guardian.

A \$75 for any type of Vehicle Camper or RV and \$50 camping pass for Tents MUST be purchased for the weekend and MUST BE DISPLAYED in the front vehicle windshield or front of camping unit at all times. (\$30 if you an exhibitor)

If you have another vehicle in addition to the vehicle hauling trailer, please specify. (Both must have car pass) If you are taking your vehicle in and out of the fairgrounds over the weekend, a \$5 car pass must be purchased.

All campers must have a 4-day wristband. All Campers must be listed on application form.

### ABSOLUTELY NO CAMPFIRES ALLOWED!

The Bulkley Valley Exhibition is a community oriented family event. The association reserves the right to evict individuals that do not adhere with the above rules. Please respect the rights of others to a 'good nights sleep'.

### **Continuing for 2022**

There will be changes to the campsite spacing due to the larger sizes of RV's and Trailers that are now the norm and the result will be less spaces available. We are going to take reservations for camping spots instead of a first come basis. This change will affect general camping primarily.

We also anticipate that the spots in general camping will be filled up by Wednesday evening. Watch for signs stating that general camping is full at the top of the hill leading into Fairgrounds.

General Campers please see the map attached and send at least 3 choices of campsites or areas and we will do our best to place you.

All reserved campsites, car passes, dog passes and people wristbands must be paid for at the time of reservation so we can make your entry into fairgrounds streamline and easy on our gate crew.

Any changes to your original purchase need to be dealt with through the office before arrival so your package is correct at the gate. E-Transfer payment to byfair@telus.net or come to Fair office.

## **GENERAL RULES: EXHIBITORS**

- EXHIBITOR with First and Last Name along with complete mailing address and phone number is required.
- All entries must be made on prescribed forms located in this book or online at www.bvfair.ca
- 3. Entry fees must accompany all entry forms. Money for exhibitors' passes and camping fees must be included if required. No refund on entry fees and/or exhibitors' passes except as outlined in livestock and horse division rules. \$25 fee on NSF cheques.
- Entry fees are shown above each Division or
- Entry forms deadline—see p.4 for each division.
- Exhibitor passes may be purchased with minimum requirements-see specific divisions for more details.
- 7. Exhibitor camping rates are available for exhibitors who meet minimum criteria established by each division.
- 8. Exhibitors who are showing in more than one division will be limited to the maximum number of passes in one division only.
- Any exhibitor, who violates any of the General Rules, or any of the rules printed herein, shall be liable to forfeit any or all prize money and awards made to such an exhibitor, and may also be barred from further competition for such a period as may be decided by the Directors.

- Please Note: ONE ENTRY FORM PER 10. Exhibitors of animals, machinery in motion, and other exhibits liable to cause accidents, injury or damage to property, or to a person coming into contact with them, shall guard their exhibits and protect the public from coming in contact there within, and every exhibitor shall indemnify the Association from and against all claims, demands, costs, charges and expenses which may occur, suffer, or be put to, by reason of accident, or any person properly guarded, or the public not being properly guarded there from.
  - 11. Each exhibitor shall assume responsibility for any injury occasioned to himself, or his assistants, while exhibiting or performing.
  - 12. The Association will take all responsible precaution to ensure the safety of exhibits sent to the exhibition, but the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibiting them, and should any exhibit, or portion thereof, be injured, lost or stolen, the Association will give assistance to the recovery of same, but will not be liable, or make payment for the value thereof. Night watchmen will be employed by the Association during the exhibition.
  - 13. All Perpetual Trophies must be returned to the office 30 days prior to the start of the Exhibition.
  - 14. Judges' decisions will be final.
  - 15. All protests or appeals must be made in writing, must state plainly the cause of the complaint, and must be delivered to the BVX General

- Manager within 48 hours of the closing of the fair, accompanied by a certified cheque for \$100, refundable if the complaint is upheld by the Board of Directors.
- 16. In offering prizes set out in this prize list, the Directors of the Association wish it to be understood that, in the event of funds at the disposal of the Association not being adequate to cover prize money in full, a pro rata reduction will be made. Special prizes offered by outside parties will be paid to the winners if received by the Association.
- 17. No reissuing of prize money cheques will be undertaken. All cheques and certificates must be cashed or redeemed by December 31 of the current year.
- 18. Exhibit removal: After 5 pm Sunday. If exhibits are removed prior to 5 pm Sunday, prize money will be forfeited.
- 19. All prize money will be mailed within 45 days of the final day of the fair.
- 20. Sale of raffle tickets is restricted to rented booths only, and must meet with the approval of the Association. Organizations are responsible for their own lottery licenses and a copy must be submitted to the office one (1) week prior to the first day of the exhibition.
- 21. The Association reserves the right to refuse or terminate any exhibit or display it deems to be illegal, immoral, or not in keeping with the atmosphere of the exhibition, and to return any entry fee without being liable for compensation.

#### E**S:** GUESTS & EXHIBITORS GENERAL

- 22. Admission to the grounds will be by ticket or pass only. No badge or ribbon will permit entry to the grounds.
- 23. All vehicle and/or camping passes issued must be hung in front windshield of vehicle or admission to the grounds will be refused. During the exhibition, vehicles not displaying passes will be towed away at the owners' expense. Vehicle passes are limited see entry forms for details.
- 24. Camping fees will be charged for each camping site on the grounds. New for this year - reservations will be accepted online at www.bvfair.ca; remaining sites will be available on a "first come basis". Additionally, all campers must purchase a
- 4-day pass to the exhibition. Camping wristbands must be worn at all times during the exhibition. All campers must complete a camping application form, available online at www.bvfair.ca and at BVX Fair Office.
- 25. Camping is family-friendly and alcohol may only be consumed in designated camp sites. Smoking or vaping of cannabis is prohibited in public places on the fairgrounds and may only be consumed in your designated camping area. The association reserves the right to evict camping guests or exhibitors who create a disturbance and/or nuisance to other campers or fairgoers.
- 26. Parking and camping are under the control of the grounds and camp managers. Guests and exhibitors must confine their vehicles and campsites to the designated areas. Violators may have their privileges revoked and/or vehicles towed at owner's expense. No vehicle movement on grounds between 10 am and 6 pm.
- 27. All dogs on the grounds must display a fair-issued permit. Further to this, Town of Smithers bylaws requires you to clean up after your dog and have your dog on-leash at all times. Any uncontrolled dogs will be removed. This policy adheres to the Town of Smithers dog leash bylaw and will be strictly enforced.





#### WHERE ARE WE?

Turn off Highway 16 at Tatlow Road on the east side of Smithers; then left on to Pacific St.

#### VEHICLE TRAFFIC

No vehicle traffic inside fenced area from 10am-6pm. Please observe and obey the signs to keep congestion to a minimum and allow safe pedestrian traffic. The Exhibition provides roughly 1,100 parking spaces. Parking is on a first-come basis. Please obey parking attendants stationed throughout the parking area.

- Gate 1 Camping Gate is a vehicle entry & exit gate
- Gate 2 Re-Entry, General Admission all day, Service Vehicle access until 10
- Gate 3 General Admission, pedestrian only access
- Gate 4 Livestock Gate is a vehicle exit gate

#### ON-SITE CAMPING

On-site camping is available to exhibitors and the general public on a firstcome basis. Space is very limited and reservations are strongly encouraged. All persons camping must purchase a 4-day camping pass in addition to the camp site fee. All campers must fill out a camping application. Parking and camping are under control of the Grounds and Camp Managers, and campers must confine their vehicles and campsite to the designated areas. Violators may have their privileges revoked. No vehicles to move on the grounds between 10am-6pm.

FEE: \$75/camping unit trailers/rv's \$ 50 site per tent(tax incl.)
