GENERAL RULES:

- 1) Entries will close August 14, 2021. **All entries to include full payment and photocopies of registrations.** No late entries will be accepted.
- 2) **2021 Note: Prize money amounts will be subject to entry levels and sponsorship.**
- 3) There will be no prize money awarded unless the exhibit is worthy or otherwise marketable.
- 4) Owners are responsible to feed and water their own stock. Shavings will be provided. **Note: Livestock owners are liable for damage or injury caused by their animals.**
- 5) Barn space will be allocated by the BV Exhibition.
- 6) All animals exhibited shall be free from contagious or infectious diseases. The Committee may have any animal inspected by a Veterinarian prior to unloading. The Committee may order the removal from the grounds or isolation of any animal considered by the Veterinarian to be contagious or infectious.
- 7) **Exhibits may not be removed from barns until after 4 pm on Sunday.** Out of town exhibitors may request early removal – 2:00pm on their entry form but no trailers or trucks in until after 4:00pm. We can assist with equipment haul out to parking lot.
- 8) All exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their stalls. Include information about the entries and the exhibitor. Educating the public and potential customers is very important in the promotion of your product and contributes to the fair's goals and objectives. Decorations may not be removed until after 4 pm on Sunday.
- 9) All livestock exhibitors are required to clean their stalls and pens before leaving the grounds.
- 10) No refunds will be issued without a veterinarian certificate.
- 11) Livestock should not be on the grounds before Thursday, except by prior arrangement with division contact.
- 12) All livestock trailers and trucks must be parked outside of the gates.
- 13) Prize money will be mailed after the Fair.
- 14) Exhibitors must abide by all rules or prize money will be forfeited.
- 15) No animals allowed in the camping areas.

Prize Money: 1st \$70; 2nd \$60; 3rd \$50; 4th \$40; 5th \$30 (unless otherwise indicated – see general rules)

Entry Deadline: August 14th, 2021

RULES

- 1) All cattle must be shown on a halter.
- 2) Bulls over one year of age cannot be shown without either a ring in the nose or use of a humbug. Bulls over one year of age must be handled by a mature handler.
- 3) All cattle must be tied with a safety rope in addition to a halter.
- 4) All animals must display CCIA RFID tags. Untagged animals will not be allowed on the premises.
- 5) All animals exhibited in the classes of registered livestock must be registered in the name of the exhibitor at closing date of entries. The animal's name, date of birth, and registration number must be given on the entry form. Current-year animals do not require registration certificates but must be eligible for registration and properly identified. All Angus entries MUST be registered at the time of judging and proof of registration provided. **Photocopies of registrations must be sent with entry forms.**
- 6) All animals exhibited must be weighed on Thursday at the prescribed times.
- 7) If more than 20 head in any class, the committee may split class and pay out prizes on each class.
- 8) All animals exhibited **must** be owned by the exhibitor or the exhibitor's family.
- 9) All exhibitors must have an exhibitor's pass.
- 10) 4-H members entering Open Classes must pay regular entry fees.
- 11) Exhibitor must wear exhibit number and animal information.
- 12) All clipping/grooming chutes are restricted to designated areas only.
- 13) Angus Show animals are NOT to have any colour products applied to them.
- 14) Animals may not be tied to the ring fencing (inside or outside) except for holding until the next class.

A1a: Registered Beef Cattle

BREED CLASS: Ang – Angus (Registered) / Her – Hereford (Registered) / Lim – Limousin (Registered) / Cha – Charolais (Registered) / Sim – Simmental (Registered) / AOB – All other breeds (Registered). If there are fewer than three breeders (from different farms) and 10 animals in any breed, they will be placed in the "All other breeds" class.

- 101 Heifer calf born 2021

- CHAMPIONSHIP: Junior & Reserve, Ribbon only
- 121 Female born 2019 with 2021 calf. To be judged as a unit.
 - 131 Female born prior to 2019 with 2021 calf at foot. Judged as a unit.
- CHAMPIONSHIP: Senior & Reserve, Ribbon only

141 Bull calf born 2021

151 Yearling Bull born 2020

CHAMPIONSHIP: Junior & Reserve, Ribbon only

161 Bull: born between Jan 1 - Dec 31, 2019

CHAMPIONSHIP: Grand & Reserve, Ribbon only

171 Breeder's Herd (Group of 4, bred by exhibitor, both sexes must be represented.)

181 Get of Sire (3 animals from the same sire, both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by exhibitor). Must be shown in previous classes.

191 Progeny of Dam (2 animals, any sex). Must have been shown in previous classes.

SUPREME COW: The Grand Champion female (registered) from each breed class will return to the ring to be judged for overall Supreme Cow.

SUPREME BULL: The Grand Champion male (registered) from each breed class will return to the ring to be judged for overall Supreme Bull.

101 Heifer calf born 2021

111 Yearling heifer born 2020

121 Female born 2019 with 2021 calf. To be judged as a unit.

131 Female born prior to 2019 with 2021 calf at foot. Judged as a unit

A1c: Junior Beef Class

RULES: Exhibitors must be under age of 21 years in the calendar year. No requirement for Junior Association membership, but animal(s) shown must be owned by the Junior or the Junior's family farm. If more than one animal in the entry, another Junior must assist.

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

No entry fee, but must be on an entry form. No late entries accepted. Open to 4-H also.

Showmanship: 70%

Condition of Exhibit: 20%

Appearance of Exhibit: 10%

101 Junior Showmanship (age 10 and under)

111 Intermediate Showmanship (age 11-15)

121 Senior Showmanship (age 16-21)

Next 4 classes: Entry fee: \$5

TROPHY: Joe Utz Memorial Trophy (perpetual) (points from junior showmanship, and junior beef classes 131, 141, 151 and 161 for Hereford animals)

171 Junior Beef Fitting Class
