

- 1) A team member must wear a show harness with an exhibitor number issued by show officials.
- 2) Contestants must bring any and all materials needed to the fitting area 15 min. before start time.
- 3) Contestants may not use inappropriate fitting methods. Unethical fitting situations include, but are not limited to:
 - Any altering of the natural color of the animal by the use of dyes, paints, hair coloring conditions, colored show foam, graphite, colored powders or other substances.
 - The addition of any hair or hair like substances (including twine), false tailheads, and false polls (false tail switches are allowed)
- 4) Time limit: 30 minutes
- 5) Clippers may be used at the discretion of team members.
- 6) After fitting time, each entry will be held in line by one of the fitters to be viewed by the judges.
- 7) Judges will base placing on both fitting techniques and final results.
- 8) In the event of sub final or final heat:
 - Teams will be allowed 5 minutes back in the chute
- 9) Criteria for Supervising adult:
 - Adult may not help, touch animal, or assist participants except in the case of preventing injury.
