RULES:

- Zucchini Race Cars must be submitted for judging no later than 1:50pm on race day.
- 2) Car must be made of a real zucchini and must be the main part of the entry.
- The zucchini racer must be no more than 8 inches wide, including wheels and decorations.
- 4) Wheel axles must be incorporated into the zucchini itself. It's not acceptable just to attach a zucchini to an existing 'vehicle' that rolls. This means no attaching a zucchini to a skateboard, roller skate, toy car, etc.
- 5) Each racer must be self-propelled. No motors or auxiliary propulsion.
- 6) Please create a zucchini racer sturdy enough to compete in multiple races.
- Wheels and axles may be All-Organic or Recycled. "All-Organic" means homebuilt using wood, vegetable pieces or

plastic but not metal. "Recycled" wheels may be reused from an old toy car or skateboard as long as they abide by General Rules.

HALL DIVISION RULES

NEW!! – All exhibits for Division L2 (Photography) must be DIGITAL and must be entered online and your photos uploaded with your entry. If this is a huge problem, please phone the office 250 847 3816.

- An Exhibitor's Pass may be purchased with a minimum of 5 entries in Divisions B, E, F, G, J, K, L & T.
- Note: New Hall entry form deadline is August 14, 2021. Exception: Division E (Vegetables & Flowers) – Saturday, August 21, 2021. Entry forms may be dropped off at the office or at the BV Fair Booth at the Farmer's Market. Payment must accompany entry form.
- 3) All exhibits in Divisions E, F, G, J, K, L & T must have been completed, or grown by the exhibitor in the past 12 months, unless article has not previously been entered for competition at this fair.
- Only one entry in each class (Divisions E, F, G, J, K, L & T) by each exhibitor will be allowed.
- If only one (1) entry in a class, no 1st place will be awarded unless the item is deemed of exceptional quality.
- 6) Judges decisions will be final.
- Basis for awarding most points (Divisions E, F, G, J, K, L & T): three points for first, two points for second and one point for third, where applicable. Director's decision will be final.
- 8) Exhibits for Divisions B, E, F, G, J, K, T1, T2, T3, T7, T9 (except quilts) and V will be accepted between 10 am and 4 pm, Wednesday, August 25. Exhibits will not be accepted after 4 pm.
- 9) Exhibits for Divisions L1 (Arts) and Quilts T4, T5, T6, T9 (classes 10-11) will be accepted ONLY at the following times: August 20 between 5 pm and 9 pm and August 21 between 10 am and 2 pm—NO EXCEPTIONS. This will aid in a more efficient display of exhibits; to allow for proper hanging.
- 10) Exhibits for Division L2 (Photography) must be entered online.
- 11) No exhibits will be released unless exhibitor number is presented. The number of exhibitors allowed in the hall at one time may be restricted by the Association to ensure safe removal of exhibits.
- 12) The office will be open Monday to Thursday following the fair from 10 am to 4 pm. Exhibits must be picked up by the Tuesday of the week following the fair.
- 13) Cash payouts will be made for winnings under \$10. If not picked up, all other prize money will be mailed within 45 days of the final day of the fair.
- 14) A "FOR SALE" sign (2"x3") may be left with the Hall Committee to be attached to articles AFTER judging has been completed.
- 15) Hall Tags for entries will be available for pickup on August 24 at the BVX office during the day and at the Hall during the drop-off times listed above.
